Key Accountabilities

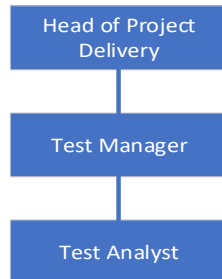
- Analyze and provide feedback about functional and non-functional requirements to eliminate ambiguities.

- Collaborate with software developers and other project team members.
- Validate and document completion of testing and development.
- Comply with defined testing processes, methodologies and frameworks.
- Provide feedback and recommendations to improve software development processes.
- Provide feedback about tested work items meeting company guidelines and standards.
