

Dingley Recycled Water Scheme

Transfer Main



Works in Waterways starting from early 2026

Supplying recycled water to local parks, world-class golf courses, sporting ovals, laundromats, market gardens and nurseries, the scheme will help preserve our drinking water supply, and help our communities become more resilient to climate change.

You may have seen us and our delivery partner Abergeldie, BMD, KBR Joint Venture (ABK) in the area recently. Site set up commenced in Pillars Road in late September 2025. We've also been working in Black Rock, Beaumaris and Cheltenham on the West Connection Network of the scheme.

We'll be working in sections of around 100-200m to minimise impacts to residents and the community, starting from the Springvale Road end of Braeside Linear Reserve. We expect to spend 4-6 weeks in each section, depending on the weather. In each section we'll undertake ground investigations, excavation activities, underground drilling, pipe installation, and then reinstatement works. Works in Waterways should take around 3-4 months.

We'll keep our website updated with our progress and letter drop affected residents and businesses before we start works in each area.

When we've finished, we'll return any areas we've impacted as close as possible to their original condition. This will include reseeding grassed areas in the Reserve.

The scheme could save up to 300 megalitres of drinking water every year. That's 300 million litres or 120 Olympic swimming pools!



We're installing a pipeline and a new pump station as a part of this project.



It should take 12 months to construct the 12km Transfer Main and pump station.



We'll be working in and around Braeside Linear Reserve with surround lane closures as needed.

Transfer Main - Waterways

With some works in Waterways you might see us or our delivery partner Abergeldie, BMD, KBR Joint Venture (ABK) around.

What to expect while we work

We'll do our best to keep impacts to a minimum, however these are some things you might notice while we work:

- Lane closures near the Linear Reserve
- · Less car parks in the area
- More trucks in the area
- Noise from heavy machinery and construction activities
- Storage areas for materials and equipment

Our team will be around during working hours to make sure people, bikes and cars can move around safely.

Locals will still have property access throughout the works.

However, there may be during working hours.

There may be times where your property access is temporarily restricted. If this is the case, we will reach out to you directly in advance of the works.

You shouldn't notice any change to your water or sewer services while we work.



When it's happening

We're planning to work in Braeside Linear Reserve, Waterways in early 2026 for around 3-4 months. We'll be in touch before works start to provide more detailed dates.

We'll then cross Governor Road and work through Braeside Park and the Mordialloc Freeway Reserve into Old Dandenong Road.

We'll letter drop affected residents and businesses with more information before works start in each area.

Working hours are Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm. Occasionally, we may have to work at other times. This may include Saturdays, between 7am and 5pm, depending on our progress.

If we do need to work on Saturdays, we'll let you know via SMS and email. Check your contact details are up to date on your mySouthEastWater account using the QR code.

You'll notice machinery and materials as well as temporary fencing around the area. The area will be secure with strict safety requirements.


We expect to occupy this area until works in Waterways are completed. We'll do our best to minimise our impact to the community in the area.
